
## Pakistan: A comparative analysis of 2020 and 2021 draft personal data protection bills

The Ministry of Information Technology and Telecommunications ('MOITT') is entrusted with the development of a law on personal data protection. In April 2020, the MOITT issued a consultation draft of the Personal Data Protection Bill 2020 ('the 2020 Draft') and, based upon this consultation, a revised draft was issued in August 2021 ('the 2021 Draft').
